

## General Funds

At Rockford Health System, we offer the highest level of medical care and services available in the region. In addition, we strive to provide a warm and comforting environment where patients have the best chance to heal and recover from illness or injury. The items listed below, which fall outside tight departmental budgets, were requested by several departments throughout Rockford Health System to give patients and their families that extra touch of caring at a stressful time in their lives. Please join us in our mission to deliver superior care to our patients by making a special gift to the fund of your choice.

**#1 Piano Fund** to provide various items for the Steinway grand player piano, donated to the hospital lobby to provide soothing piano music to patients and families. Fund is used to purchase piano discs of classical, jazz, pop, and holiday music, to hire professional pianists to play on occasion, and for general piano tuning and maintenance.

Having a child in the hospital can be an anxious time. Knowing there is a warm and welcoming place for your child to stay can make all the difference in the world. The beautiful Children's Medical Center at Rockford Health System offers the region's most advanced care for infants, children and adolescents. The Center is also home to a staff of physicians with years of advanced training and experience in nearly 20 different specialties – more specialized care than anywhere else in the region.

### Child Development & Behavior

**#11 Down Syndrome Guide Books** to teach parents about the motor development of their children with Down Syndrome and help them set goals. \$19 each, 6 needed.

**#12 Dental Brochures** to help parents of infants in the Neonatal Follow-Up Clinic develop good dental habits for their children. \$135 total.
